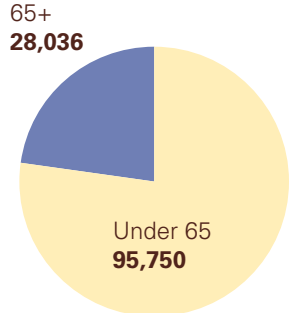
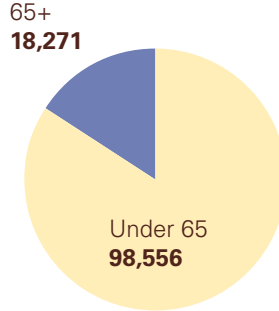
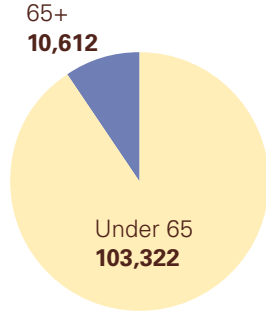
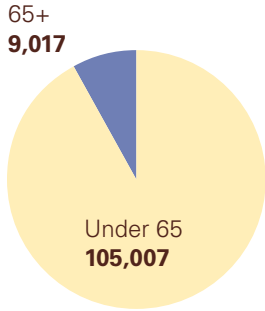


# ANN ARBOR POPULATION TRENDS BY AGE
